Qualification & Eligibility for (A&B):

For (A):

Essential Qualifications:-

“Master’s degree with 55%marks(or an equivalent Grade in a point-scale wherever the Grading system is followed) in Comparative Religions or in the allied disciplines/subjects of Religious Studies, History, Sociology, Social Anthropology, Philosophy, Political Science or Indic Studies, from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.”

Desirable:

“Ph.D. or research experience in the concerned/relevant disciplines/subjects mentioned above with focus on religion as a strong component of Research”.

- i) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:-

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;

- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

- B.** The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Qualification & Eligibility for (B):

- i) Master's Degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the concerned/relevant allied subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/foreign University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be:-

Provided further, candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges / Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) Ph.D. degree has been awarded to the candidate in a regular mode
b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which, at least one is in a refereed journal;
e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in Conferences / seminars supported/funded/sponsored by the UGC/AICTE/ICSSR or any other similar agency.

Note 1: The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note 2: The clearance of NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC (like SLET/SET).

OR

A traditional or a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the subject concerned having a Bachelor's degree, who has:-

- i) Studied under a noted/reputed traditional Master(s)/Artist(s)
ii) Has been 'A' grade artist of AIR / Doordarshan;
iii) Has the ability to explain, with logical reasoning the subject concerned; and
iv) Has adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in the discipline concerned.


Note:-

1. Applicants are requested to kindly submit the prescribed Application Form in the concerned Department/Centre, JMI.
2. There will be no fee for filling up the application form for the above positions.
3. The concerned Department/Centre will screen the application of the candidates and will call for interview accordingly.

4. Selection against vacancy shall not confer on the appointee any right of permanent appointment/regularization.
5. Relaxation, if any, shall be as per the UGC guidelines and other regulatory bodies.
6. Number of positions advertized herein are provisional and may vary.
7. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview. The University reserves the right to restrict the candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed or by any other condition that it may deem fit. The University may constitute a Screening Committee to scrutinize the applications and short-listing the candidates.
8. Eligibility of candidates will be determined as on the last date of submission of application forms.
9. (a) The Jamia reserves the right to evolve a uniform and reasonable criterion for short-listing of eligible candidates, if needed.
(b) Jamia also reserves right to give preference to those who possess higher qualifications.
10. Candidate must enclose the attested copies of degrees, diplomas and mark-sheets etc. giving reference of experience/published work with application form.
11. Incomplete application or application on plain paper will not be entertained and is liable to be rejected.
12. Knowledge of Urdu and Hindi is a desirable qualification for all teaching posts.
13. The University reserves the right to hold/not to hold Selection Committee for any or all of the post(s).
14. Canvassing, in any form or on behalf of the candidate will be a disqualification.
