Qualification & Eligibility for (A&B):

For (A):

Essential Qualifications:-

"Master's degree with 55%marks(or an equivalent Grade in a point-scale wherever the Grading system is followed) in Comparative Religions or in the allied disciplines/subjects of Religious Studies, History, Sociology, Social Anthropology, Philosophy, Political Science or Indic Studies, from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university."

Desirable:

"Ph.D. or research experience in the concerned/relevant disciplines/subjects mentioned above with focus on religion as a strong component of Research".

Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:-

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;

e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

OR

B. The Ph.D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Qualification & Eligibility for (B):

- i) Master's Degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) in the concerned/relevant allied subject or an equivalent degree from an Indian/foreign University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be:-

Provided further, candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances / Bye-laws / Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges / Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) Ph.D. degree has been awarded to the candidate in a regular mode
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted:
- d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which, at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two research papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in Conferences / seminars supported/funded/sponsored by the UGC/AICTE/ICSSR or any other similar agency.
- Note 1: The fulfillment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affair) of the University concerned.
- Note 2: The clearance of NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC (like SLET/SET).

OR

A traditional or a professional artist with highly commendable professional achievement in the subject concerned having a Bachelor's degree, who has:-

- i) Studied under a noted/reputed traditional Master(s)/Artist(s)
- ii) Has been 'A' grade artist of AIR / Doordarshan;
- iii) Has the ability to explain, with logical reasoning the subject concerned; and
- iv) Has adequate knowledge to teach theory with illustrations in the discipline concerned.

Note:-

- 1. Applicants are requested to kindly submit the prescribed Application Form in the concerned Department/Centre, JMI.
- 2. There will be no fee for filling up the application form for the above positions.
- 3. The concerned Department/Centre will screen the application of the candidates and will call for interview accordingly.

- 4. Selection against vacancy shall not confer on the appointee any right of permanent appointment/regularization.
- 5. Relaxation, if any, shall be as per the UGC guidelines and other regulatory bodies.
- 6. Number of positions advertized herein are provisional and may vary.
- 7. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview. The University reserves the right to restrict the candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed or by any other condition that it may deem fit. The University may constitute a Screening Committee to scrutinize the applications and short-listing the candidates.
- 8. Eligibility of candidates will be determined as on the last date of submission of application forms.
- 9. (a) The Jamia reserves the right to evolve a uniform and reasonable criterion for short-listing of eligible candidates, if needed.
 - (b) Jamia also reserves right to give preference to those who possess higher qualifications.
- 10. Candidate must enclose the attested copies of degrees, diplomas and mark-sheets etc. giving reference of experience/published work with application form.
- 11. Incomplete application or application on plain paper will not be entertained and is liable to be rejected.
- 12. Knowledge of Urdu and Hindi is a desirable qualification for all teaching posts.
- 13. The University reserves the right to hold/not to hold Selection Committee for any or all of the post(s).
